It is very convenient because I can use it whenever I want. I can take my time when I drive my car or I can drive fast if I need to arrive somewhere quickly.

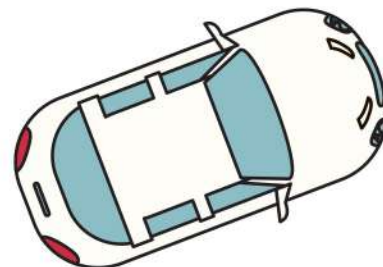


During my childhood my favourite car was a Mercedes Benz and I was quite excited when I saw one on the street. My dream car is an Audi because it looks very cool.
